#### JOB SUMMARY

As a member of an interdisciplinary team made up of youth advocates, social workers, creative arts therapists, and educators, the Case Manager III will provide both one-on-one support and group programming to help enhance the social, emotional, physical, and financial well-being and autonomy of young adults.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide case management delivery where clients play an active role in the development and implementation of an individual action plan targeted to their unique goals, needs, and aspirations
- Deliver culturally responsive, healing-centered services to a diverse young adult population, with a focus on neurodivergent young adults
- Develop and facilitate therapeutic, wellness, and social groups, life skills workshops, community-building activities, and special events
- Assist in the ongoing evaluation of group programming, in response to evolving client needs
- Provide psycho-social support, including supportive counselling, accompaniment, coaching related to life and social skills
- Support clients in development and achievement of an individualized plan that includes concrete goals, actionable items, and timelines toward social, emotional, financial, and physical well-being
- Connect clients to external resources, including public services, and collaborate with service providers to ensure clarity of roles and efficiency of services
- Collaborate and consult with diverse internal and external professionals, coordinate and advocate with other services and networks
- Staff and support the L'Annexe drop-in centre
- Fulfill all administrative and data requirements, including regular documentation of progress notes
- Represent L'Annexe within the agency and broader community. Serve on intra- and external committees
- Actively participate in clinical & peer supervision

#### REQUIREMENTS

- Master's degree in social work, or another professional equivalent
- Minimum of 3 years experience working with young adults (ages 16-35)
- Experience working with neurodivergent individuals and knowledge of ASD
- Member of a professional order is an asset
- Knowledge of the Montreal and Quebec social service networks, government programs and services
- Understanding of systems theory and a demonstrated ability to link theory to practice
- Experience providing strengths-based support in a clinical or community setting
- Commitment to providing LGBTQ+ affirming services
- Experience with Trauma Informed Practice and/or Healing Centered Engagement is an asset
- Fluently bilingual in French and English. We require English communication skills due to many of our clients being from the English-speaking community.
- Knowledge of the Jewish community is an asset
